



#### HIGHLIGHTS FROM 2018/2019



It was the beginning of something beautiful—and sweet! In May 2019, we built the *9th Meadow Apiary*, 3 buzzing hives, and officially launched Project Bee, a 4-part workshop series to educate the community about the impact of pollinators, enhance local bee populations, and offer a sanctuary for honey bees at Wintergreen.
