



# BEESWAX WRAPS



Beeswax wraps are easy to make and great alternatives to single use plastic like plastic wrap and plastic bags.

## Materials:

- 100% Cosmetic Grade Beeswax pellets
- Cotton fabric
- Parchment paper
- Iron



## Instructions:

Choose some fun fabric and wash and cut the fabric into the preferred wrap size. Do this to remove any dust, starches or chemicals from the fabric.

Place piece of fabric on top of a piece of parchment paper and sprinkle on the beeswax pellet. Sandwich your fabric and wax between two pieces of parchment paper and with your iron, spread and melt the wax evenly into the fabric. Take a peek and if you notice some spots are missing wax add some more and keep ironing. Once the wax is melted hang the wraps to dry.

## How to use:

To use the beeswax wrap, simply wrap the beeswax wrap around your food item and hold the wrap in place with your hands, the warmth from you hands will mold the beeswax into shape.

## Cleaning Instructions:

To clean the beeswax wrap, rinse it under cold water and use soap if you'd like, and wipe or hang dry. It is important to NOT use hot water because it will melt the beeswax.
